A free exchange place for users in 3 waste disposal centers (Champ-sur-Drac, Vif and Saint-Martin-d'Hères) with the project to extend it to other centres.

Building A

1,100 m² Ground Floor: anti-food waste and reusable glass bottle and packaging. 650 m² First floor: training activities for new skills within the circular economy.

Building B

4,500 m² industrial platform for sorting, dismantling and to provide an extensive reuse, repair and upcycling service to the general public.

Building C

Business incubator and accelerator. 750 m² Ground floor for housing workshops, storage spaces, showroom, new activities in the textile industry, sport and leisure items, wood etc. 750 m² First floor for coworking space.

Building A

Encourage synergies between actors of the circular economy for reducing food waste and providing returnable food and drink containers



→ DEVELOP SYNERGIES BETWEEN ACTORS

ENCOURAGE NEW SOLUTIONS

- * Reusable food and drink containers for restaurants: 75 partner restaurants in 2021 and 40,000 disposable containers saved from landfill across 4 departments.
- Cleaning and logistics of containers to replace disposable packaging with reusable containers.
- * Home delivery of meals trialled in the city of Grenoble,
- * Cooperation with Réseau Consigne (French returnable packaging association).





- * Development of the chain for reusable glass containers (bottles and jars),
- Support for shops and producers who want to offer their customers reused. zero-waste. products.
- * Cooperation with Réseau Consigne (French returnable packaging association).

27.500 bottles have been reused to date



- * An eco-friendly, community-based association that produces food products led by la Conserverie du carreau,
- Vse of otherwise wasted food products (unsold items, scraps and waste from farming etc.),
- * Healthy and good quality meals cooked and presented in jars,
- * A back-to-work scheme.



FROM COLLECTION... **TO RESALE**



Collection

Fabricanova is a major actor in waste collection:

- presents every Saturday at a participating waste disposal centre at the "Donation zones" to collect any waste that can be reused,
- offers a "rendez-vous" service for the collection of large waste items.
- manages the voluntary drop-off point on the Pôle R site.



Training and Integration

Fabricanova offers training and new jobs in the circular economy for peole in professional integration schemes.



Sorting and dismantling

The platforms for the sorting and reuse redirect objects to local chains.

Resale

Fabricanova développe d'autres modes de commercialisation pour la vente des objets traités [magasins éphémères ou évènements).

Reuse, repair or upcycle

The Fabricanova site offers a space for repairing objects, on both a permanent and occasional basis. Objects will then be resold to reuse retail points.
